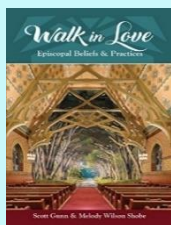


## Understanding & Developing our Faith

- 3. FUTURE CLASSES:** This series provides the clergy with insight into what topics you are hungry for, or need more of, which we will offer more on later in the year.

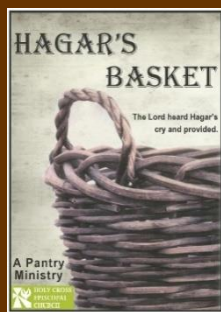
