IT'S GONNA BE AN ADVENTURE

But you do not even know the half of it!

Of course, you do, in fact, know that in just a few weeks our new parish hall expansion will be operational. This hall has the capacity to do so much that we have never been able to do, including host speakers, large classes, and even (who knows) informal worship opportunities. I could not be more excited or more grateful to God and you that we have been able to accomplish this long needed and desired addition. For this reason alone, this fall is going to be an adventure, **but you still don't know the half of it!**

With the help of our diocese, the young adults of our church (ages 18-25ish), the vestry, and I will be launching a new Young Adult & College Ministry based at UWF. Its name is *The Point*. This group's mission is to create and foster a dynamic community for young adults, regardless of whether they are enrolled in college or attend a church. They will meet weekly at (or near) UWF and will be an open group that explores *the point* of life through conversation, service to others, and a heck of a lot of fun. Katie Diamond is the coordinator of our leadership team – Miya May, Philip Iversen, Sam Klauss, and Nat Winn. Please pray for this ministry. **But you still don't know the half of it!**

All that we do, as a church community, misses the mark if we do not continue to find ways to grow in our faith and faithfulness to God via Jesus Christ. To actually accomplish this, year after year, takes focused intent and inspiration. This fall, our entire church will engage in the offering developed by our Presiding Bishop, Michael Curry, named *The Way of Love: Practices for Jesus Centered Life*. To quote Curry, "For centuries, monastic communities have shaped their lives around rhythms and disciplines for following Jesus together. Such a pattern is known as a 'Rule of Life.'" We are not trying to be a monastic community (relax!), but *The Way of Love* is the framework for such a rule for our lives. It explores seven practices - **Turn - Learn - Pray - Worship - Bless - Go – Rest**. By having themes across the church campus, we hope to foster

meaningful conversation and growth within our homes and across different church groups. This fall, we will engage in this meaningful adventure together. **But...you guessed it...you still don't know the half of it!**

To begin this fall adventure, we will start by reviewing what unique gifts/abilities each of us carry with us, at this point in our lives. Donovan Chau has been working hard with me to bring you a truly meaningful, practical, and helpful version of a "Spiritual Gifts Inventory." On Kickoff Sunday, August 18, the entire congregation is going to gather in our new Parish Hall to explore, understand, and articulate our natural gifts and to see how that information can help us to better plug into our church and our world. Let's fill the parish hall up to the brim for this class! (Makeup date is Wednesday, August 21). **But still you don't know the half of it!**

We also have both *Financial Peace University*, being offered by our Parent Group on Wednesday nights this fall, and *First/Early Communion Classes and Celebration*, for children 2nd Grade and higher, offered in Sept. **But still you don't know the half of it!**

Well...okay. Maybe **now** you know the half of it; however, who could have foreseen what is happening at Holy Cross? And I am not even talking about all the activity. I mean the love. I mean the joy. I mean the growth in faith and understanding. I mean the *real and true church* being brought to life and flourishing here in our midst. I know I couldn't have foreseen it. Therefore, I know...I *know* that when it comes to what God is doing, none of us really know the half of it. But in the end, it is going to be sooo good. I didn't say easy. I said, "good." My honest prayer is that you will go on this adventure with me this fall.

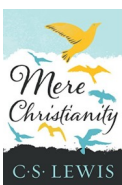
